Chabad rabbis, holocaust survivors, a 10-year-old girl: Who are the Bondi attack victims?



Those lost in the attack included Chabad rabbis, children, grandparents, Holocaust survivors, businessmen and people just getting their start in life.

A Chanukah celebration on Bondi Beach in Sydney to mark the first night of the holiday turned into a mass tragedy and one of the most severe antisemitic terror attacks since the Hamas invasion of Israel on Oct. 7, 2023.

The incident demonstrated not only the cruelty of the assailants but also the heroism of ordinary people who tried to stop the attackers, as well as the sense of loss for those who were victims of the shooting.

Those lost in the attack included Chabad rabbis, children, grandparents, Holocaust survivors, businessmen and people just getting their start in life.

Joseph's imprisonment finally **ends** when **Pharaoh** **dreams** of **seven fat cows** that are swallowed up by seven lean cows, and of seven fat ears of grain swallowed by seven lean ears. **Joseph interprets the dreams** to mean that seven years of plenty will be followed by seven years of hunger, and advises Pharaoh to store grain during the plentiful years. **Pharaoh appoints Joseph governor of Egypt**. Joseph **marries Asenath**, daughter of Potiphar, and they have two sons, **Manasseh and Ephraim**.

Famine spreads throughout the region, and food can be obtained only in Egypt. Ten of **Joseph's brothers** come to Egypt to purchase grain; the youngest, Benjamin, stays home, for **Jacob** fears for his safety. **Joseph recognizes his brothers**, but they do not recognize him; he accuses them of being spies, insists that they

bring **Benjamin** to prove that they are who they say they are, and imprisons **Simeon** as a hostage. Later, they discover that the money they paid for their provisions has been mysteriously returned to them.

Jacob agrees to send Benjamin only after Judah assumes personal and eternal responsibility for him. This time Joseph receives them kindly, releases Simeon, and invites them to an eventful dinner at his home. But then he plants his **silver goblet**, purportedly imbued with magic powers, in **Benjamin's sack**. When the brothers set out for home the next morning, they are pursued, searched, and arrested when the goblet is discovered. Joseph offers to set them free and retain only Benjamin as his slave.

TORAH GEMS

Like a Date Palm

"A righteous man will flourish like a date palm, like a cedar in the Lebanon he will grow tall." (Psalm 92:13) The Rabbis enumerate the many distinctive properties that make the palm tree a symbol of virtue and righteousness: —The palm grows straight, without bending, just as the righteous man remains upright and honest. The wood of the palm is free of knots, just as the righteous man is free of flaws. —The palm's shady leaves and fronds are far off the ground, at the very top of the tree. Similarly, the reward promised the righteous is not

immediate, but is reserved for the distant future of the World to Come. — Every part of the palm is useful: its fruits are eaten, its leaves and fronds are used in thatching, and its wood is used for construction. Similarly, each righteous Jew fulfills a special purpose (Bereishis Rabbah 41:1).

The renovated kitchen and dining room at the Na'amat Canada Glickman Centre for Family Violence Prevention, now a warm and dignified space where women can prepare and share meals with their children.



The new therapy room at the Glickman Centre, offering women and children an additional avenue for healing through music and therapeutic activities.



The Musical Playground at the Rhodie Blanshay Benaroch Children's Centre, while also recognizing the need for upgrades to the main outdoor play and gathering area.



The new middle school building at Kanot, where we witnessed the joy and confidence of students learning in a modern environment. Completion of the second floor for Grade 9 students will proceed once funding is secured.



The thriving students at the Hadera Technological High School, whose pride was evident as they welcomed us with treats, they had baked themselves. On the school's wish list is a new hairdressing salon—one of its primary educational streams—which the principal envisions as a welcoming and fully functional learning space.



The resilience of the staff and children at our Sderot Multipurpose Daycare Centre. The dedication of the caregivers truly goes above and beyond to provide stability and care for the families they serve.

These were just some of the highlights of what we experienced. Our services extend far beyond these programs, and we were fortunate to meet dedicated staff members at several of our other facilities as well.

I thank you sincerely for all that you have done—and continue to do—to support the essential work of Na'amat. Your generous support has been instrumental in enabling us to respond swiftly and compassionately to the evolving and unexpected needs of vulnerable individuals within our social service and educational networks during these traumatic times.
