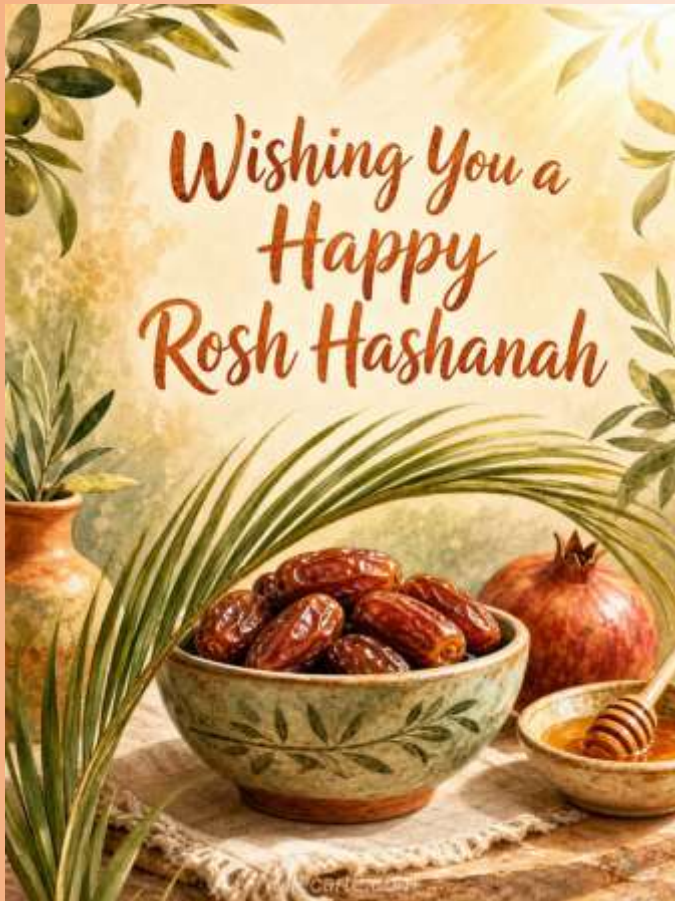

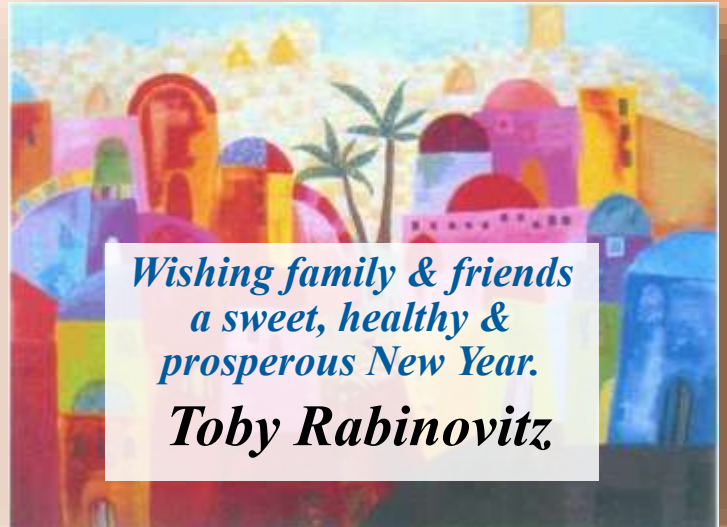

Candle Lighting Blessings for Yom Kippur ...

High Holidays 2026



All women and girls (or, if there isn't a woman in the house, the head of the household), light candles at least 18 minutes before sunset – see [this link](#) for the exact time – and recite the following blessings:

1. בָּרוּךְ אַתָּה אֲדֹנָיִי אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם אֲשֶׁר קִדְּשָׁנוּ בְּמִצְוֹתָיו וְצִוָּנוּ לְהַדְלִיק נֵר שֶׁל (שַׁבָּת וְשֶׁל) יוֹם הַכִּפּוּרִים

Bah-rookh ah-tah ah-doh-noi eh-loh-hay-noo meh-lekh hah-oh-lahm, ah-shehr ki-deh-shah-noo beh-mitz-voh-tahv veh-tzee-vah-noo leh-hahd-lik nayr shehl [if Yom Kippur is on Shabbat add: shah-bahtveh-shehl] yohm hah-kee-poo-rim.

Blessed are You, L-rd, our G-d, King of the universe, who has sanctified us with His commandments and has commanded us to kindle the light of [*if Yom Kippur is on Shabbat add: Shabbat and*] Yom Kippur.

2. בָּרוּךְ אַתָּה אֲדֹנָיִי אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם שֶׁהַחַיִּים וְקִיּוּמָנוּ וְהַגִּיעָנוּ לְזֶמֶן הַזֶּה

Bah-rookh ah-tah ah-doh-noi eh-loh-hay-noo meh-lekh hah-oh-lahm sheh-heh-kheh-yah-noo veh-kee-mah-noo ve-hig-ee-yah-noo liz-mahn hah-zeh.

Blessed are You, Lord our G-d, King of the universe, who has granted us life, sustained us, and enabled us to reach this occasion.

If the one lighting the candles intends to drive to synagogue for the *Kol Nidrei* prayers, she should have in mind while lighting the candles that she is not just yet accepting upon herself the sanctity of the holiday. She should then immediately proceed to the synagogue, without undue delay.

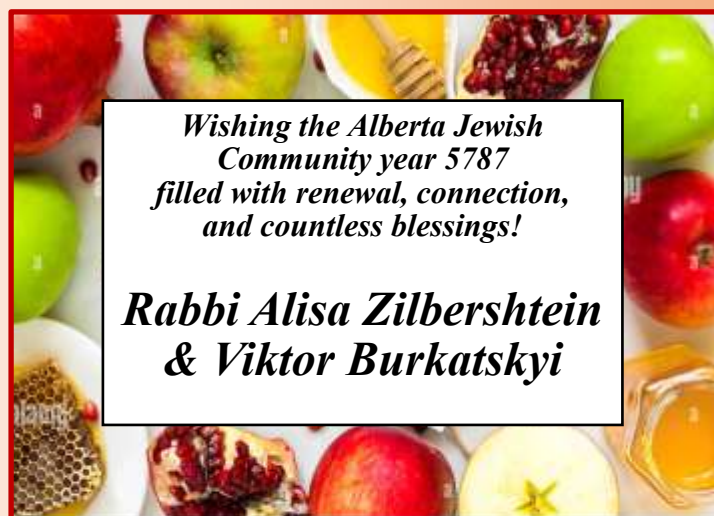

I'm voting for a strong Alberta within a united Canada which is why I'm voting Option 1 for Alberta to stay in Canada

I am a proud Albertan and a proud Canadian. Those two identities have never been in conflict for me. 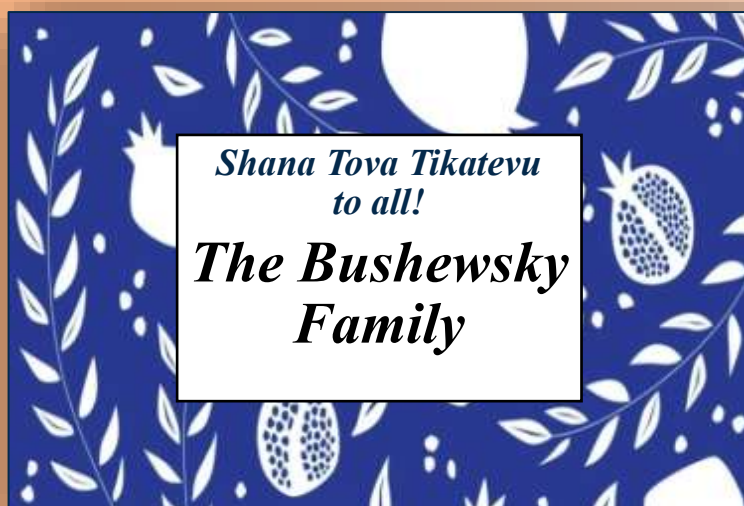

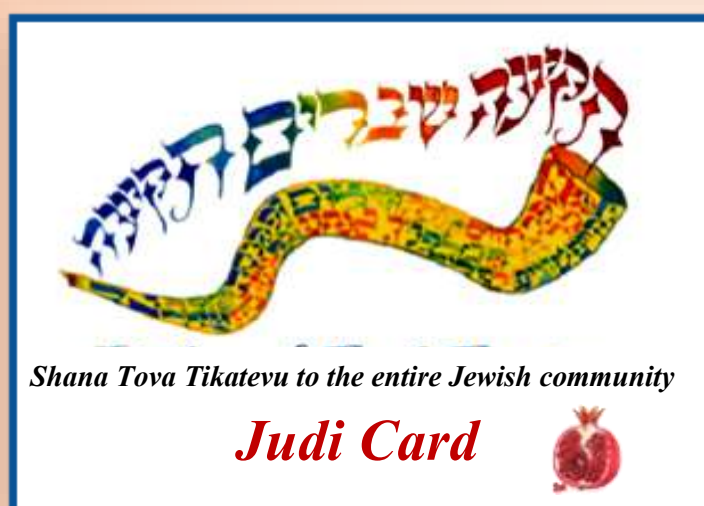

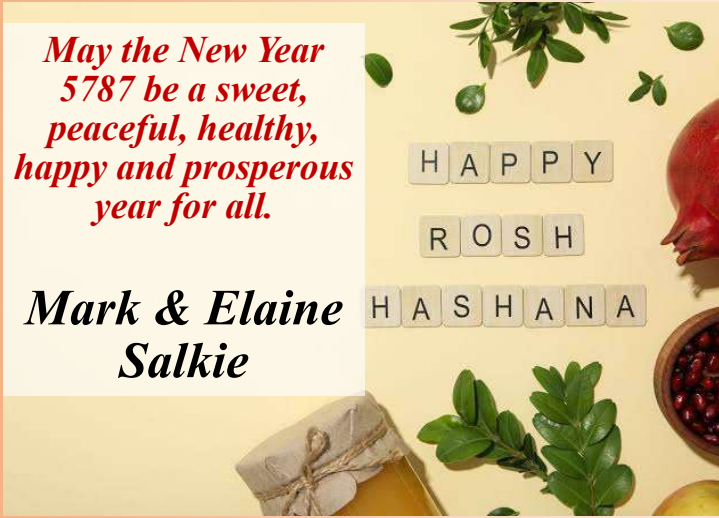

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VISITING THE GRAVES OF OUR LOVED ONES BEFORE YOM KIPPUR...



There is a meaningful custom of visiting the graves of our loved ones during the period surrounding Rosh Hashana and Yom Kippur. What thoughts should enter our hearts and minds when we make this visit?

We can gain an insight from a thought-provoking Talmudic teaching. The Talmud says that one who visits a cemetery is not permitted to perform mitzvot 'in the presence' of those who are buried (Brachot 18a). The following examples are offered – one is not to wear tefillin on one's head and not to carry a Torah scroll and learn from it in a cemetery. The Talmud states that this is an 'affront' to the dead. The Talmud then quotes the verse from Proverbs (17: 5), "He who mocks the poor affronts his Maker." The 'poor' in the verse symbolizes the deceased in the cemetery who no longer can observe the commandments. This law is generally understood to mean that it is inappropriate to perform a mitzvah in the presence of those who no longer can.

“HAAZINU” in a Nutshell ...



The name of the Parshah, "Haazinu," means "Listen" and it is found in [Deuteronomy 32:1](#).

The greater part of the [Torah](#) reading of [Haazinu](#) ("Listen In") consists of a 70-line "song" delivered by [Moses](#) to [the people of Israel](#) on [the last day of his earthly life](#).

Calling [heaven and earth](#) as witnesses, Moses exhorts the people, "Remember the days of old / Consider the years of many generations / Ask your father, and he will recount it to you / Your elders, and they will tell you" how [GꝀd](#) "found them in a desert land," made them a people, chose them as His own, and bequeathed them a bountiful land. The song also warns against the pitfalls of plenty—"Yeshurun grew fat and kicked / You have grown fat, thick and

rotund / He forsook [GꝀd](#) who made him / And spurned the Rock of his salvation"—and the terrible calamities that would result, which Moses describes as [GꝀd](#) "hiding His face." Yet in the end, he promises, [GꝀd](#) will avenge the blood of His servants, and be reconciled with His [people](#) and [land](#).

The [Parshah](#) concludes with [GꝀd](#)'s instruction to Moses to ascend the summit of Mount Nebo, from which he will behold the [Promised Land](#) before dying on the mountain. "For you shall see the land opposite you; [but you shall not go there](#), into the land which I give to the children of Israel."

"YOM KIPPUR" Torah Readings in a Nutshell ...



The Torah reading for [Yom Kippur](#) morning describes the service performed on this day by the [Kohen Gadol](#) (high priest) in the [Holy Temple](#) in [Jerusalem](#).

A special feature of the Yom Kippur service was [the casting of lots over two he-goats](#) — equal in age, size and appearance — to determine which shall be offered to G_d in the Holy Temple, and which shall be dispatched to carry off the sins of Israel to the wilderness.

The climax of the service was when the [Kohen Gadol](#) entered the innermost chamber in the [Temple](#), the "[Holy of Holies](#)." Wearing [special garments](#) of pure white linen, the *Kohen Gadol* would enter the sacred place with a pan of burning coals in his right hand, and a ladle containing an exact handful of [ketoret](#) in his left. Inside the Holy of Holies, he would place the *ketoret* over the coals, wait for the room to fill with its aromatic smoke,

and hastily retreat from the holy place.

"This shall be an everlasting statute for you," the [Torah](#) reading concludes. "...For on this day He will forgive you, to purify you, that you be cleansed from all your sins before G_d... once a year."

During the afternoon Minchah service, we read chapter 18 of Leviticus, which details the prohibitions against incest and other deviant sexual behaviors. The [Torah](#) reading is followed by a *haftarah* (reading from the Prophets) which tells the [story of Jonah](#) — the prophet who was sent to prophesy the destruction of the sinful city of Ninveh, [ran away](#) from G_d, was swallowed by a fish, and learned the power of [prayer](#) and [repentance](#) to evoke G_d's mercy and annul the harshest decrees.
