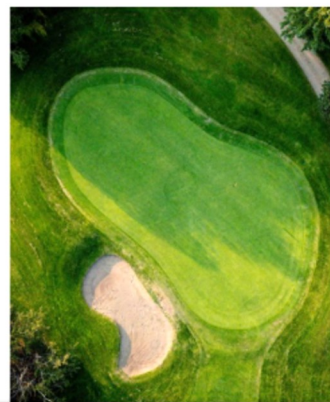

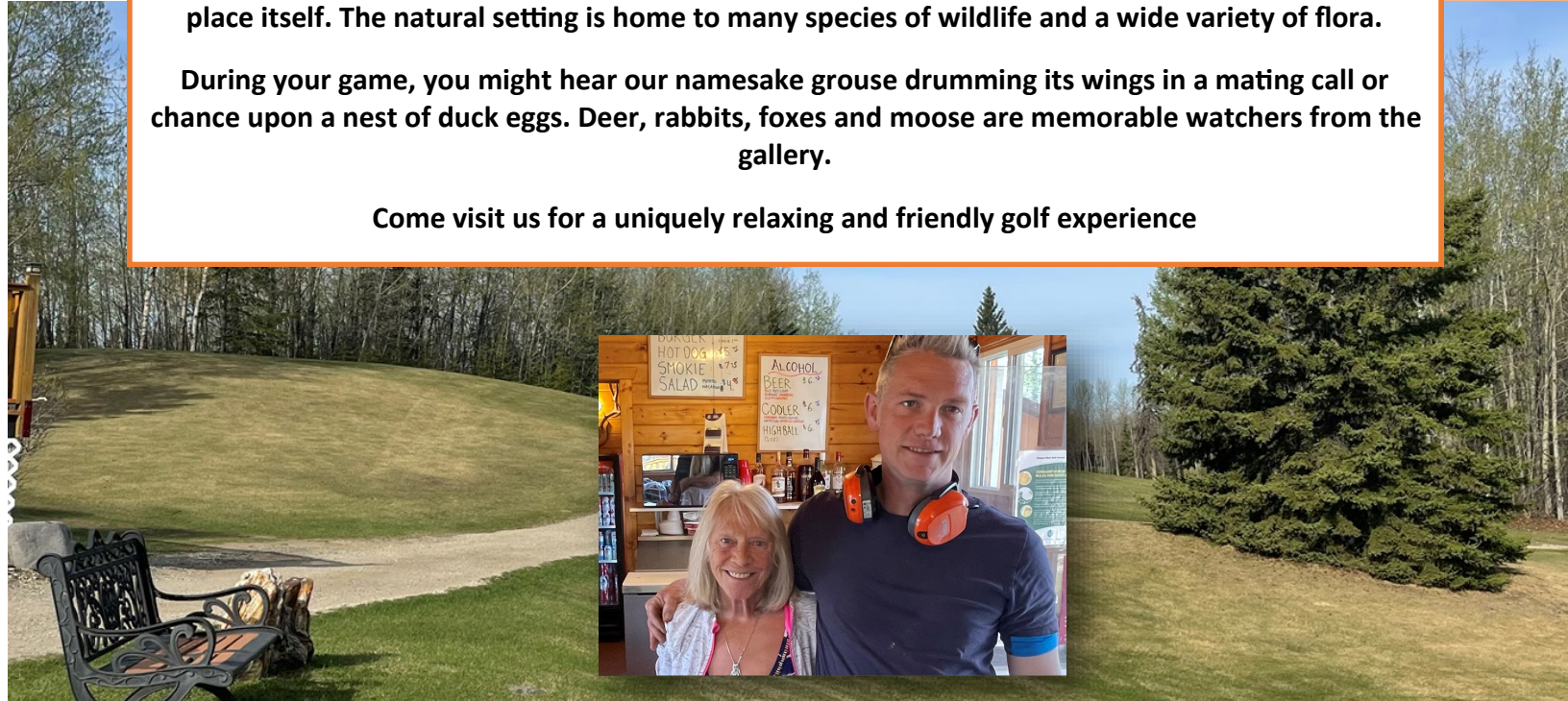

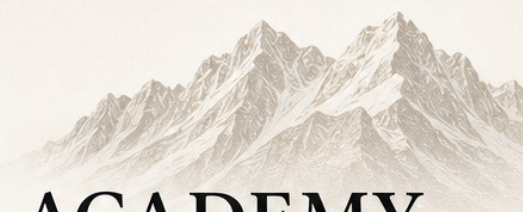

TORAH GEMS

The World's Water Supply

"He sends the springs into the streams, they flow between the mountains." (Psalm 104:10)

Radak vividly describes how God engineered the world's water supply as a marvel of technical ingenuity that efficiently serves all human needs. First, God designated the enclosed areas of the seas and oceans. Since these mammoth bodies of water are relatively still, they could have become huge, stagnant swamps due to all the plant and animal life that decays in

them. Therefore, God made the seas salty to prevent such putrefaction.

On the land masses that were not covered by the sea, God provided rivers and springs of fresh, cold water. These streams have many uses, including consumption by humans and animals, irrigation of crops, cooling of the air, and the provision of moisture for parched organisms and for the atmosphere. In addition, the swift flow of the current serves as a source of energy. The spring waters do not remain in one place, but flow in streams. This clever design frees them from

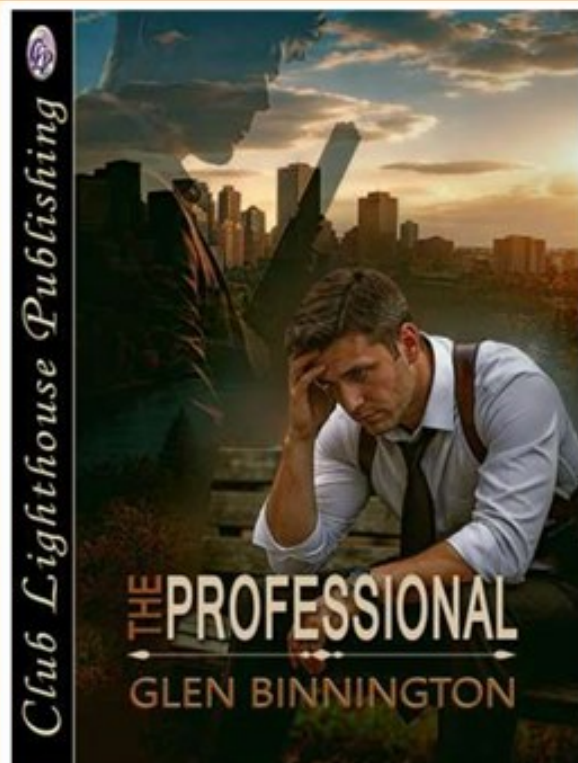
