TORAH PORTION "EIKEV" NUTSHELL ...



The name of the Parshah, "Eikev," means "because," and it is found in [Deuteronomy 7:12](#).

In the [Parshah](#) of [Eikev](#) ("Because"), [Moses](#) continues his closing address to the children of Israel, promising them that if they will fulfill the commandments ([mitzvot](#)) of the [Torah](#), they will prosper in the [Land](#) they are about to conquer and settle in keeping with G-d's promise to their forefathers.

Moses also rebukes them for their failings in their first generation as a people, recalling their worship of the [Golden Calf](#), the rebellion of [Korach](#), the sin of the [spies](#), their angering of G-d at Taveirah, Massah and Kivrot Hataavah ("The Graves of Lust"). "You have been rebellious against G-d," he says to them, "since the day I knew you." But he also speaks of G-d's [forgiveness](#) of their sins, and the [Second Tablets](#) which G-d inscribed and gave to them following their repentance.

Their forty years in the desert, says Moses to the people, during which G-d sustained them with daily [manna](#) from heaven, was to teach them "that man does not live on bread alone,

but by the utterance of G-d's mouth does man live."

Moses describes the land they are about to enter as "flowing with [milk and honey](#)," blessed with the "[seven kinds](#)" (wheat, barley, grapevines, figs, pomegranates, olive oil and dates), and as the place that is the focus of G-d's [providence](#) of His world. He commands them to destroy the [idols](#) of the land's former masters, and to beware lest they become haughty and begin to believe that "my power and the might of my hand have gotten me this wealth."

A key passage in our [Parshah](#) is the second chapter of the [Shema](#), which repeats the fundamental mitzvot enumerated in the Shema's first chapter, and describes the rewards of fulfilling G-d's commandments and the adverse results (famine and exile) of their neglect. It is also the source of the precept of [prayer](#), and includes a reference to the [resurrection of the dead](#) in the [messianic age](#).

TORAH GEMS

"Man and Woman"

(A wise] design will watch over you [and] understanding will safeguard you — to rescue you from the way of evil ... to save you from a strange woman...who forsakes the husband of her youth and forgets the covenant of her God..." (Proverbs 2:11-12, 16-17)

The covenant refers to her obligation to keep Hashem's commandments and not betray her "husband" (Metzudos). God inserts His Holy Name in the

partnership of man and woman — the letter Yud of God's Name Yah is in Ish, "man", and the letter Heh is in Ishah, 'woman'. If a couple is disloyal to Him, Hashem removes His Name from them. Only the Aleph and Shin — Eysh, 'fire' - remain with them, and will consume them (Ibn Ezra).

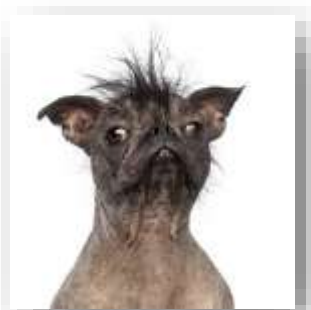

Jackson Koivun says he couldn't relax at 3M Open till he hit 18th fairway

Jackson Koivun chunked a tee shot on 18 on Sunday at the 3M Open but found the fairway and he cruised to his first-ever victory.

Scottie Scheffler posted his fifth second-place finish on the PGA Tour on July 26 in the 3M Open. Rookie Jackson Koivun was rock-solid and didn't open the door for Scheffler by making mistakes down the stretch at the TPC Twin Cities, so Scheffler settled for another runner-up check (\$959,000) while Koivun made \$1,584,000 for his first PGA Tour title.

Shots fired at Jewish Bakery in Toronto

Toronto Police Service (TPS) is investigating two suspected hate-motivated attacks targeting separate locations of Jewish-owned **Kiva's Bagel Bakery** on Sunday morning, including one in which a window was struck by gunfire.

Police were first called shortly after 8 a.m. to the Yonge Street and St. Clair Avenue West area after reports of a shattered window. Investigators found evidence that a firearm had been discharged but no injuries were reported. Less than 20 minutes later, officers responded to another Kiva's location, about 14 kms north near Bathurst Street and Steeles Avenue West, after receiving reports of a broken window. Police found no evidence of gunfire or injuries reported at that location.

The TPS Hate Crime Unit, Guns and Gangs Integrated Task Force, and local officers are canvassing both areas for evidence. TPS said both incidents occurred sometime overnight and continue to appeal to the public for information.

No suspect descriptions have been provided as of press time.

Speaking to reporters across the street from the site of the first incident about three hours after it was reported, TPS Duty Insp. Scott Bradbury said investigators believe the attacks are connected and are treating them as suspected hate-motivated offences. "Right now, we don't know what the connection is other than that it's the same Jewish-owned business chain and that it happened sometime overnight." He said all the police knew at that point was that the incidents occurred "sometime after the establishment closed and when they opened and that's when the employees from the stores gave us a call."

Netanyahu, amid reported Iranian security threat, takes off secretly for Trump meeting

Without journalists on board, PM leaves from military base for first White House meeting in five months, as US president seeks to return to negotiations with Tehran

Iran will top the agenda in his meeting with US President Donald Trump, Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu said on Monday, minutes before taking off from an Israeli Air Force base for Washington, DC.

"In these complex times one must act with both great determination and great wisdom," he said in a Hebrew-language video statement, alongside his wife Sara, at the entrance to the Wings of Zion prime ministerial plane. "We will discuss all the issues on the agenda, first and foremost Iran. Of course, our goal is to safeguard our security while also expanding the circle of peace around us."

Netanyahu took off without publicizing his departure in advance, and left from an Air Force base rather than Ben Gurion Airport, reportedly for security reasons. His video statement was released only after his departure was belatedly confirmed.

The JDIC is a vibrant, inclusive hub dedicated to enhancing the lives of seniors aged 55 and over, from all walks of life and faiths. The Centre includes a large social hall, programming area and a non-certified kosher dairy kitchen. It provides a warm, welcoming environment where members can connect through diverse cultural, educational, and recreational programming. The Centre is known for fostering intergenerational connections and celebrating the rich cultural heritage of its members.

Position Overview

The Executive Director (ED) provides strategic leadership and operational management to fulfill JDIC's mission. The ED is responsible for the delivery of all programs and services, ensuring the safety and functionality of the physical facility, and securing financial resources necessary for sustainability and growth.

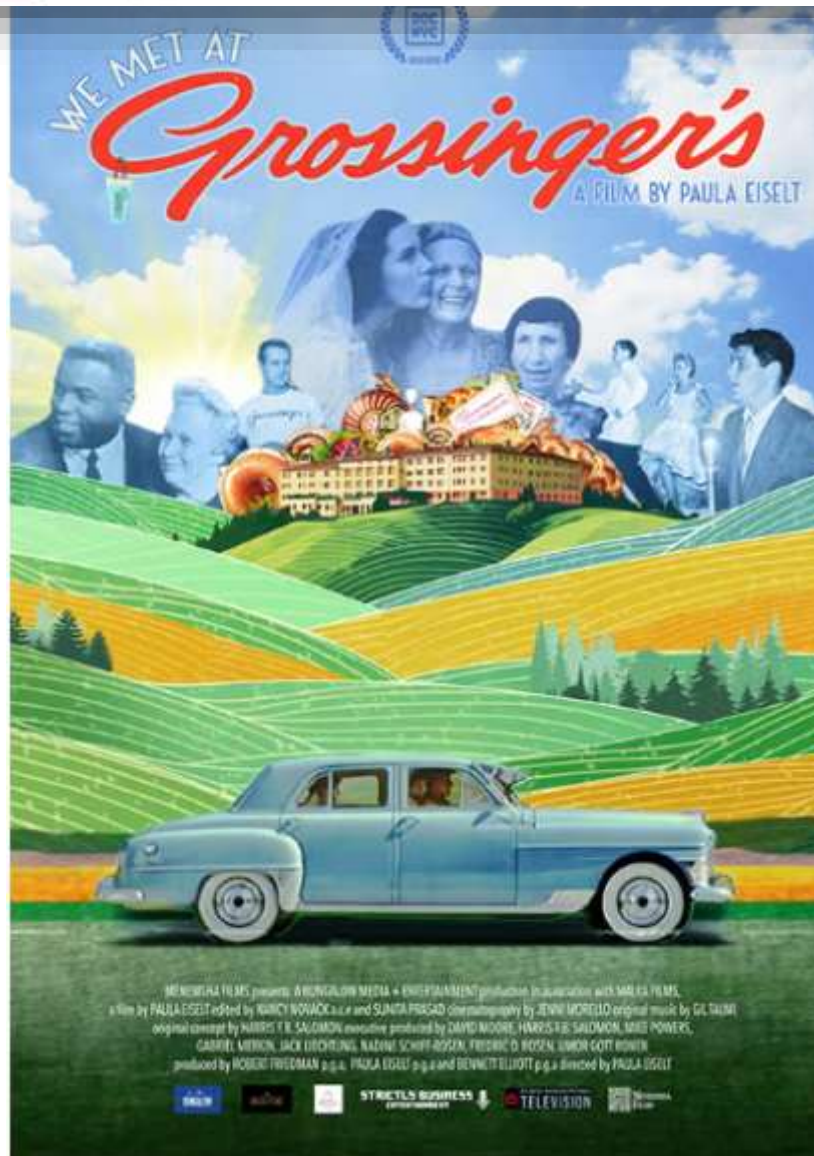

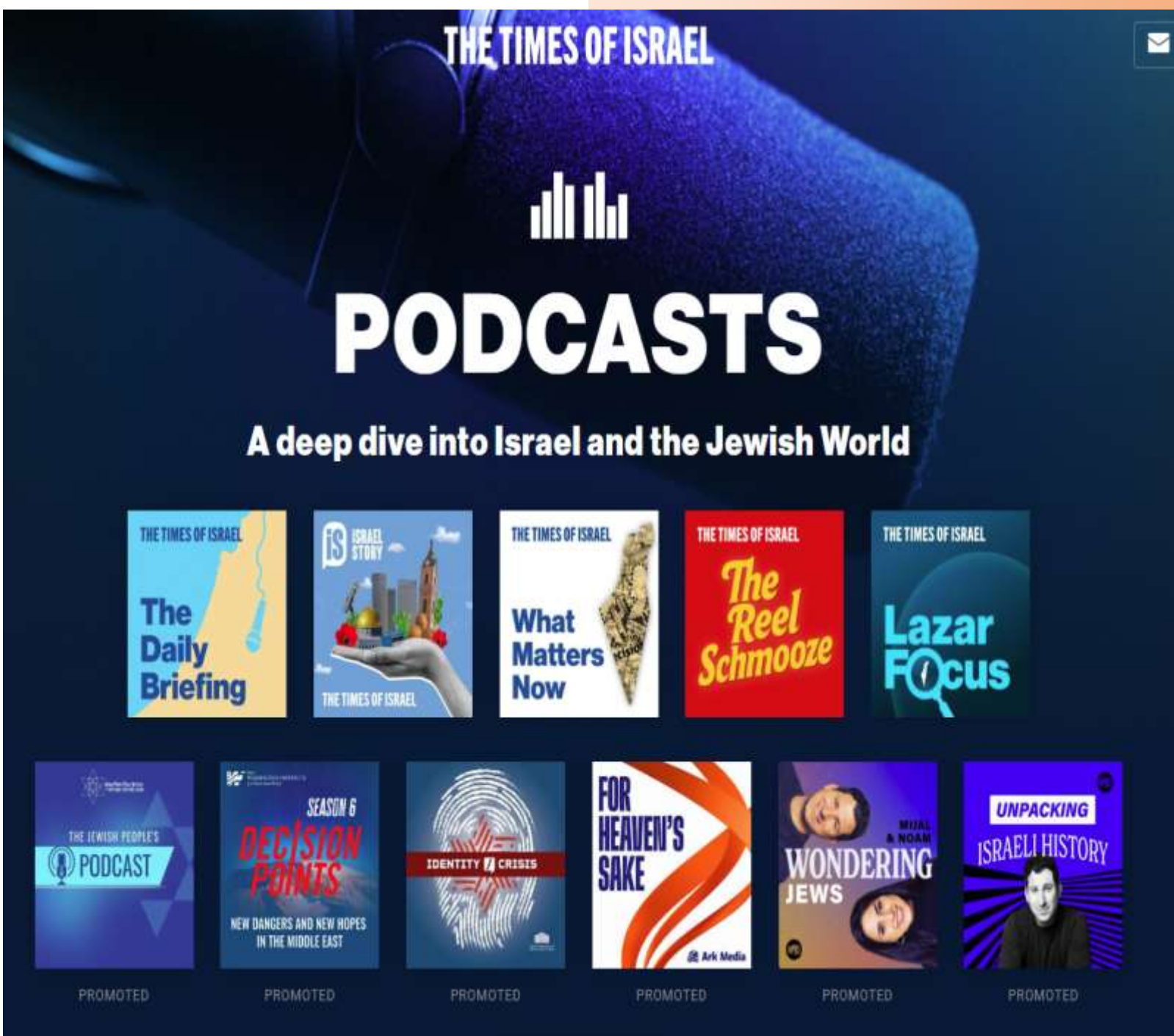
